

Benchmarks of Success for Maryland's Workforce System

Data and Dashboard Committee Charter

Vision

The Benchmarks of Success for Maryland's Workforce System is a framework used by Maryland workforce development system partners to build system effectiveness, support transparency about progress, and help State and local WIOA partners align resources and strategies with its intentions.

Mission

The mission of the Data and Dashboard Committee is to develop a consistent, sustainable system all workforce partners can use to measure, analyze display and apply Benchmarks data to continuously improve the quality and effectiveness of services.

Committee Goals

- Maintain a glossary of terms.
- Develop a timeline for activities.
- Develop processes and tools for reporting benchmark performance.
- Develop baselines for benchmarks and expected targets to measure progress on system effectiveness metrics.
- Measure system progress in meeting benchmarks.
- Provide ongoing technical assistance for data analysis-related issues.
- Develop recommendations for future measurement and calculation of benchmarks.
- Explore potential platforms for data sharing across partner agencies, such as the MD Think.

 Maintain communication with the WIOA Alignment Workgroup and other committees.

Meeting Schedule

The Committee will hold regular two-hour meetings on a monthly basis, and may occasionally meet more often, as needed.

Membership and Roles

The Committee will include 12 – 16 members who represent stakeholders from the core partner organizations identified in the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Maryland State Plan. Membership should include individuals who represent both State and local perspectives and reflect geographic diversity.
