ORDER

This matter comes before the Maryland Real Estate Commission ("Commission") as the result of a complaint filed by the Commission against the Respondent Real Estate Broker Shawpin Jong with Nations Realty, Inc., license registration number 01-301260. Based on the complaint, the Commission issued a Statement of Charges and Order for Hearing dated April 25, 2012 and transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Hearings for a hearing on the charges. The Office of Administrative Hearings scheduled a hearing for October 2, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. at the Office of Administrative Hearings in Wheaton, Maryland. At the hearing, the Commission and the Respondent entered into a Settlement Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

**BASED ON THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT DATED OCTOBER 2, 2012, IT IS THIS 2<sup>ND</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 2012 BY THE MARYLAND REAL ESTATE COMMISSION:**

**ORDERED** that the Respondent has violated Md. Code Ann., Bus. Occ. & Prof. Art., §17-322(b)(1), (24)(ii) and (25) by failing to disclose on his June 10, 2010 application to renew his real estate broker's license that he had plead guilty to and been convicted on August 26, 2008 of a misdemeanor, specifically theft over \$100, in the District Court of Maryland for Montgomery County, Case No. 000212807; and it is further

**ORDERED** that as a penalty for the violation the Respondent's real estate broker's license shall be suspended from November 15, 2012 through November 30, 2012; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Respondent shall pay to the Commission a civil penalty of \$1000.00 no later than November 30, 2012;

**ORDERED** that this Order shall be reflected among the records of the Commission.
